Why volunteer with TGC?

The club was founded in 1978 and currently has over 25 squad and development gymnasts and around 125 recreational gymnasts, plus a team of 10 paid coaching staff members and 3 young volunteers supporting the sessions. All of this is made possible because of the dedicated volunteer committee of parents, carers and other supporters. When you join our volunteer committee, you help ensure this hive of activity in Tetbury is carried out safely, with passion, and could help develop the club even further to impact the lives of many more young people.

Role purpose:

- To provide expertise to the committee in one of the following subject matters:
 - Human resources
 - Public relations
 - Management
 - Health and safety

What skills and attributes do you need?

- An expertise in the relevant subject matter, usually coming from a recent or current professional background
- Knowledge and understanding of the law in relation to the subject matter
- Ability to professionally challenge the committee on areas relating to the subject matter
- Observant and inquisitive
- Ability to discuss the subject matter in simple language understood by all

Some of what you will do:

- Lead on relevant tasks in the subject matter area of the organisation. For example an HR expert would lead on staff recruitment.
- Annually review the relevant policies relating to the subject matter and make recommendations to the committee for updates.

Commitment:

- A minimum of 4 committee meetings per year, plus preparation time
- One AGM per year, plus preparation time
- Ad hoc sub-committee meetings as required, plus preparation time
- Tasks between meetings as required
