Why volunteer with TGC?

The club was founded in 1978 and currently has over 25 squad and development gymnasts and around 175 recreational gymnasts, plus a team of 12 paid coaching staff members and 3 young volunteers supporting the sessions. Role purpose:

- To support the coaches to set up the gym hall ready for the session ahead.
- To support the coaches to pack away the gym hall at the end of the session.

What skills and attributes do you need?

- Physically fit (much of the equipment is heavy)
- Ability to follow instructions
- Ability to work as part of a team

Some of what you will do (some of this is limited for volunteers under 16):

- Moving large, heavy equipment, often in pairs, such as the bar frames and beams.
- Holding bar frames in position whilst the safety chains are fitted to the floor anchors.
- Moving other equipment such as boxes, springboards, trampettes,
- Prepare an annual report and present at the AGM

Commitment:

- Ideally we are looking for regular volunteers, 2 or 3 per set up/pack down. You can sign up to just one time slot per week, or be part of a rota with another volunteer to help us fortnightly.

 - o Saturday set up, 8.00 8.45am
 - Saturday pack down, 3.15 3.45pm
